

It is the Effingham Public Library. I can go to the library to check out books and movies.


#### This is where we go into the library.




We park the car in the parking lot and walk inside. I can push a button to make the doors open automatically.



### This is the lobby at the library.




# The children's department is on the second floor. I can use the stairs or the elevator to go there.






## This is the children's department at my library.

### This is the children's desk at my library.




This is where the librarian works. The librarian is very helpful. I can ask the librarian to help me find a book. The librarian will answer my questions.


### There are toys at my library that I can play with.




### When I am done playing with the toys, I put them away neatly.




### This is the children's programming room at my library.




### I can go to story time here.
