Strategic Goals

Welcoming

- Create and maintain a welcoming environment
 - Prepare for the remodel of the 2nd Floor, including developing donor relationships and engaging with the architect about space needs
 - Continue to strengthen internal processes for efficiencies
- Foster opportunities to greet new residents
 - Research all hours for effectiveness and adjust as needed
- Provide library service to all
 - o Review staff roles and find the best fit as we explore library service to all
 - Continue to research impacts of providing library service to all of Effingham
 County

Communication

- Develop useful channels of communication for the community
 - Enhance our meeting room services, including an opportunity to connect with each booking about the services provided by the library and deepen our connections with each organization/business
- Facilitate communication between the community and new and existing services
 - Evaluate how foster care family visits occur in our building and how we can better serve this population
 - Continue to build and strengthen relationships with local government officials

Connection

- Create opportunities for people to engage
 - Increase active donor base by 10% (new donors)
 - Engage our volunteers by growing the number of hours served in our volunteer program by 5%
- Develop outreach initiatives that foster deeper community ties
 - Register 20 more non-resident cardholders over the previous year
 - Along with neighborhood ambassadors, canvas 15% of the neighborhoods in Effingham to encourage library card redemption



Education

- Expand opportunities for youth to connect with science, technology, and the arts
 - Hold one program per month that targets Kindergarten through fourth graders
- Foster outreach opportunities that support an active and involved community at all ages
 - Connect with at least 2 new organizations that primarily serve either the whole county or residents outside of Effingham
 - o Family Read Night 2.0 delivered to at least one school

Safety

- Support a safe environment in our community
 - Host active shooter training for our staff
 - o Update emergency plans and procedures as well as test them for effectiveness
- Partner with community leaders to educate the community about our changing neighborhoods
 - Host three community conversations around topics of interest in the community
