Strategic Goals

Family Support

- Create opportunities for families to connect and find support and services
 - o Develop a quick reference guide that can be shared with families and individuals
 - Host a 140th Birthday Party
- Partner with organizations to develop new ways to support families
 - Develop at least 5 new partnerships with local/regional organizations
 - Create programs that address isolation within the aging community
- Foster a sense of safety and connection
 - Create programs that encourage connection, such as Meditate and Mingle and Parent and Child play groups

Leadership

- Provide library service to all in our community
 - Review the space and service needs of our library and community
 - o Improve access to our meeting rooms and other open spaces
- Implement programs that position the library as a leader in the community
 - Develop a board recruitment and orientation strategy
 - o Invite local, state, and federal officials to visit the library
- Improve our marketing and communications to better connect our services to the community
 - Update Communications/Marketing Plan
 - Conduct surveys and studies to better understand the use of library services as well as general awareness
 - Develop tools for cross-promotion within the community

Education

- Support STEM and arts initiatives through schools and community groups
 - o Ensure that the Art Gallery is booked every month
 - o Develop monthly STEAM programming
- Develop pathways for communication and partnership with teachers and administrators
 - Promote the library within our local schools
 - o Partner with teachers to support the curriculum
- Implement outreach opportunities for all ages to connect with education
 - Launch the Cards for Kids program

Community

- Partner to support and develop mental health initiatives
 - Establish access to telehealth services for patrons
- Establish programs that address isolation
 - Re-envision the after school program and offerings
 - o Partner with Effingham County Museum to provide more local history lectures
- Connect the community with access to services
 - Offer computer classes in the evenings

Diversity

- Foster a welcoming environment in the library and the community
 - Training for all staff on comprehensive reader's advisory
 - Improve onboarding for new and returning patrons
 - Support staff by providing more training on empathy-based policy enforcement
- Provide access to a diverse range of topics for all ages
 - Create engaging book displays
